

Researching Co-operative Enterprise Guidance on Assessment SCQF Level 6

This pack supports the assessment of the **Researching Co-operative Enterprise Unit (SCQF Level 6)**, one of the optional units for Co-operative Studies (SCQF Level 6.)

The pack can be used to generate evidence which demonstrates that candidates have achieved all Outcomes and Performance Criteria for the Unit. Information on evidence required is contained in the unit specification.

Assessment must allow evidence of each candidate's performance to be generated and collected. This evidence must then be judged against the standards set out in the Unit specification. To achieve a Unit, candidates must generate the evidence required in relation to all Outcomes and Performance Criteria.

Instrument of Assessment 1 covering all Performance Criteria in Learning Outcomes 1 and 2 and Marking Instructions for Instrument of Assessment 1.

Instrument of Assessment 2 covering all Performance Criteria in Learning Outcome 3.

Instrument of Assessment 3 covering all Performance Criteria in Learning Outcome 4 and Marking Instructions for Instrument of Assessment 3

Instrument of Assessment 2 is a checklist to be completed by the candidate and the teacher. There must be evidence relating to all Performance Criteria in Learning Outcome 3. This will normally be contained in a portfolio of evidence collated by the candidate. For this Outcome, planned review of candidate's progress and attainment is suggested during and/or after the planning and research has been completed. This will allow candidates to improve on previous work, if necessary, to ensure that the evaluation carried out for Learning Outcome 4 is not prejudiced by lack of clarity or poor planning or research.
